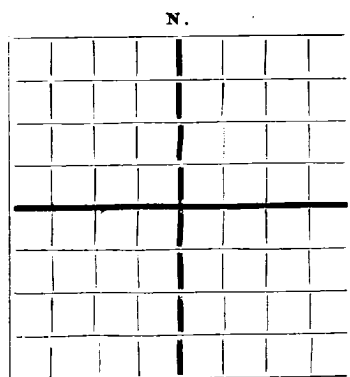

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector and approval obtained before drilling begins. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in triplicate. One copy will be returned following approval.

Dear Sir: You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as W. H. Wells Well No. 56 in Sec. 3 of T. 12 N., R. 32 E., N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated.

Size of Casing	Weight Per Foot	New or Second Hand	Depth	Landed or Cemented
15 "	75	New Conductor	250' approx.	will set and cement
10 "	45	" casing	170'	will set and cement
8-5/8"	36	" casing	4150'	will set and cement

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 4200 feet.

Additional information: Will drill with intention of encountering commercial oil at approximately 4200'. Will start by cable tool method, setting and cementing approximately 250' 15" conductor. Will drill by rotary method to top of the well bed at approximately 170', setting and cementing 10" 45 new casing. Will drill to the oil horizon with cable tools, setting and cementing 8-5/8" 36 new seamless casing at this point, using sufficient cement to prevent collapse of this string. All work to be done in accordance with best field practice and in accordance with the oil and gas regulations of the State of New Mexico.
