If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate

that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 4,080 feet.

Additional information: We propose to drill well with rotary tools to an approximate depth of 4200' unless oil or gas in commercial quantities is encountered at a lesser depth w/ casing program as outline above. All work to be done in accordance with the best oil field procedure and in conformance with all oil & gas regulations of the State of New Mexico.
