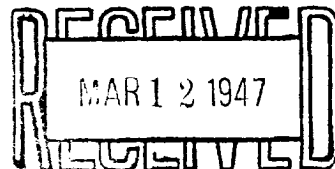

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED  
 On March 7th at 2:00 AM, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 4206 ft. of 5 1/2" 14# casing in subject well and cementing with 675 sacks. At this time casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for thirty minutes, and as shut-off tested OK, cement plug was drilled to 4203' and a pressure of 1000# again built-up and held for thirty minutes. As this test, too, was OK, workover operations were resumed.
