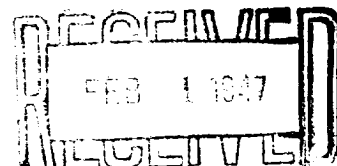

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

TD 4192. Elevation 3617. 8-5/8" casing set at 3961 with 150 sacks. It has been established that in setting 8-5/8" oil string, the quantity of cement was not sufficient to shut off the Bowers sand. In order to eliminate the hazards caused by production from the Bowers sand being open to the intermediate string, we propose to perforate the 8-5/8" casing at approximately 3200, set a retainer just above perforations and circulate cement behind 8-5/8" to the surface or to such a height above the Bowers sand that a permanent shutoff will be assured. Well will then be deepened to about 4217 and a new string of 5 1/2" casing will be set on bottom with enough cement to reach surface. Completion will then be made by perforating and setting a hook wall packer above perforations with annulus filled with refined gas-oil.
