Will set and cement approximately 200' 70# new conductor. Will set on top of the salt at approximately 1700' 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " new casing cemented. Will cement 8-5/8" 36# seamless casing on top of pay at approximately 4050'.
Will drill well with the intention of encountering oil at approximately 4050'.
Will spud and set conductor at approximately 200' by cable tool method.
Will drill rotary to top of salt, cementing 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " casing at this point, completing the well by cable tool method.
