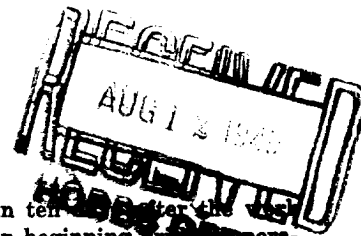

To report loss by fire caused by lightning of 34.21 net barrels oil (34 gravity) from stock Tank No. 67216 and 300.44 net barrels oil (34 gravity) from stock Tank No. 67217 as of 5:45 p.m. July 29, 1949. Tank No. 67217 destroyed and will not be replaced. Tank No. 67216 to be repaired and restrapped. Permanent tank battery storage capacity reduced from 5 TP 500-bbl tanks to 4 TP 500-bbl. tanks.
