FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION
 Total depth 4190. 6-5/8 casing set at 3976'. Recent production test was 60 Barrels of oil plus five barrels of water per day flowing on 25/64 choke. Enough water is being produced to cause well to die frequently and swabbing is necessary to restore production. It is believed water is intermediate in character and can be shut off by setting a packer. It is planned to take a Gamma Ray-Neutron Survey and then set a packer in sand break at approximately 4117' with perforations below, afterwards acidizing with 2000 gallons to stimulate oil production.
