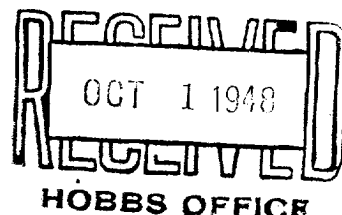

Pea gravel from 3154/3127 and Calseal from 3127/3085, pea gravel from 3085/2960. Shot off @ 8:45 a.m. 9/5/48. Ran 3174' of 2" E&E tubing, well has flowed and swabbed 224 bbls. oil to beginning of potential test 9/27/48, 76 bbls. of which was lead oil.
