Dear Mr. Drew:

On June 17, 1948, I wrote you concerning Form C-110 on your
H. D. McKinley #4 Well. To date I have not had a reply to
my letter.

My office has not received this form, and as you know, the
Shell Pipe Line cannot transport oil from this particular
well until they have an approval to do so. May I refer you
to Order 410, Sec. V, Rule 35 of the Rules and Regulations
of the Oil Conservation Commission, Circular No. 6, which
reads in part:

"--The Producer's Certificate of Compliance and
Authorization to Transport Oil, Form C-110, when
properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation
Commission shall constitute authorization to the pipe
line or other carrier to transport crude petroleum oil
from the proration or operating unit named therein--."

Again I ask that you please advise immediately concerning this
Form C-110. To avoid delay in transporting of this oil I would
suggest your filing these forms with this office immediately.
