BOND FOR CONFORMANCE WITH NEW MEXICO LAWS
AND REGULATIONS DEALING WITH OIL AND GAS.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, the Sun Oil Company, a New Jersey corporation, authorized to do business in the State of New Mexico, with its office in the County of Dallas, in the State of Texas, as principal, and American Surety Company of New York, doing and authorized to do business in the State of New Mexico, as surety, are held and firmly bound unto the State of New Mexico in the sum of Five Thousand and No/100 \$5000.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us, and each of our heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns, firmly by these presents.

Dated this 24th. day of April, 1930.

The condition of the foregoing obligation is that: WHEREAS, the above bounded principal will shortly commence and prosecute the drilling of a well to prospect for oil and gas to be known as the Henry D. McKinley Well No. One, on the following described patented land: Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 19 S, Range 38 E in Lea County, New Mexico, which is now held by Sun Oil Company under lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the above principal shall comply with all the laws, rules and regulations of the State of New Mexico and the State Geologist dealing with oil and gas up to and including the final plugging and abandonment of the well, then the above obligation is to be void and of no effect, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.
