Bradenhead Check: With tubing pressure 400 psi, 7" casing pressure 1050 psi, 9 5/8" pressure not measured due to stripped threads on casing valve, 15 1/2" casing pressure 0 psi, opened 9 5/8" valve and pressure bled off in 15 minutes with no change in 7" pressure.


