

DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

We propose to treat well with approximately 1500 gallons Hydro-Chloric acid mixture. The purpose of treating well is to raise the production to present allowable of 170 barrels daily. The present production is 150 barrels daily.

February 1, 1933 operations was started and well was deepened from 4057' to 4200' in line formation. Guiberson Spiral tubing packer was set at 4123' to shut off water coming in upper portion of pay horizon. Accomodate water shut off was made and production now obtained from exposed pay between 4123' and 4200'.
