NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on September 27, 1930. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. casing was { ~~handset~~ } in Arhydrite
formation at a depth of 2764 feet on September 23, 1930
300 sacks of El Toro cement were used.
