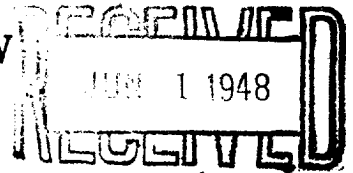

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On May 24, 1948 at 6:00 A.M. 24 hours had elapsed since running 346' of 9-5/8" new casing in subject well and cementing with 200 sacks to be used as surface string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and test was OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling operations were resumed.
