FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well was drilled to a total depth of 4314 in line and on recent swabbing tests with packer set at 4281 fluid was lowered to bottom, approximately 115 Barrels of fluid was recovered in 12 hours of which 99.5% was Sulphur Water.

Permission is requested to plug back from 4314 to 4195 using pea gravel from 4210 to 4314 and Dowell Plastic from 4195 to 4210, in an effort to satisfactorily shut off water production from this section which on previous tests did not indicate the presence of any oil.

In the course of drilling the above well, an oil show was encountered from 4147 to 4195, section in which we contemplate completing this well.
