Drilled 12" hole and ran 9-5/8" casing to 280', cemented with 300 sacks HOCO, W. O. C. 36 hours. Tested with 1000# cold water 30 minutes, held OK. Drilled 9-1/4" hole to 4050' and 6-1/4" hole to 4154'. Ran 7" OD casing to 4050' and cemented 400 sacks on bottom and 150 sacks on top of Rustler formation. Allowed to set for 36 hours & tested with 1000# pressure and held OK.
