## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "N" Well No. 1 in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 6, T. 12-S, R. 33-E, N. M. P. M., Hobbs High Oil Field Lea County, on 11/23 1930. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 70 lb. casing was { landed { in Red Bed formation at a depth of 200' feet on Nov. 12 1930. 175 sacks of cement were used.
