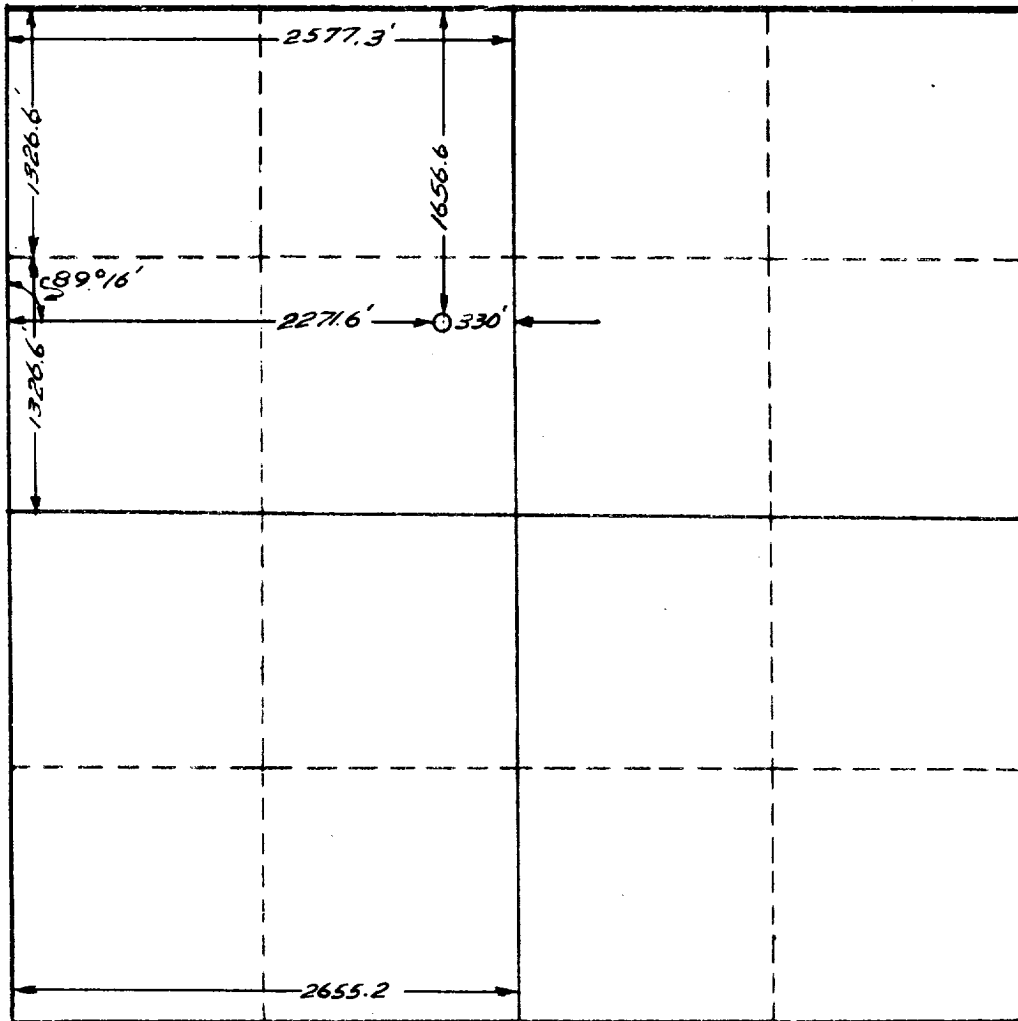


Gentlemen:

September 15, 1956, a survey was made to locate your State "H" Lease, well No. 2 at a point 330 feet from the north and 330 feet from the east lines of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6, Twp. 19 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M.

The survey was started at the west quarter corner of section 6, thence N0°44'E 996.6 feet along the west boundary of said section 6, thence East parallel with the north boundary line of the section a distance of 2271.6 feet to the location. Then to check we went N0°44'E 1656.6 feet, thence West 2577.3 feet. We were 0.4 feet west and 0.2 feet south of the section corner which is a close check of this work.
