## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was perforated from 4070 to 4095 with 4 shaped charges per foot and perforations were acidized with 1750 gallons of 15% acid. Well scrubbed dry, tubing was pulled and re-run with packer set at 4058 and old perforations were acidized with 3500 gallons 15% acid. On subsequent pumping tests well made approximately 21 barrels of oil and 5 barrels of water daily. Packer was then pulled and cement plug was drilled from 4115 to 4189 and formation was washed with 500 gallons 15% acid. On 24 hour test pumped 62 barrels of oil and 27 barrels of water.
