DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

In order to evaluate the producing ability of the "Sandy" zone under Stanolind leases in the south edge of the Hobbs Field, the interval 4028-4046' was perforated with 4 shaped charges per foot and acidized with 3,000 gallons of 15% regular acid.

Production since treatment (May 2, 1951 through May 13, 1951) has averaged 12 barrels of oil per day.
