## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on February 2nd 1931. 8-5-8" 36# lb. casing was ~~landed~~ { cemented } in Lime  
formation at a depth of 3998' 8" feet on January 29th 1931  
100 sacks of El Toror Oil Well cement were used.
