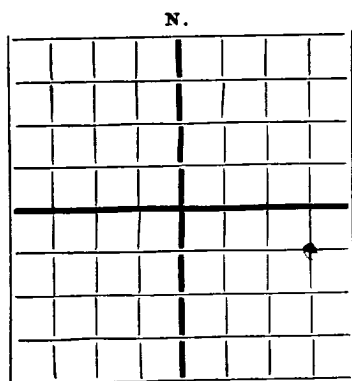

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about _____ feet.

Additional information: Will drill the well with the intention of encountering commercial oil at approximately 4000 ft. Well will be drilled rotary method, setting and cementing 200 ft. of new 16" 70# conductor. Will set approximately 2700' of 10-5/4" 45.50# new seamless casing cementing this string back into the Salt horizon. Will set and cement approximately 4000' of 8-5/8" 30# new seamless casing. All work to be done according to the best oil field practice and conforming to the oil and gas regulations of the State of New Mexico.
