## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in **Hobbs High** Well No. **1** in **NE 1/4** of Sec. **9**, T. **19**, R. **38**, N. M. P. M., Oil Field **Lea** County, on **2-28-28** 19 **50** lb. casing was { **landed** } in **Red shale** formation at a depth of **1517' 1"** feet on **2-21-28** 19 **75** sacks of **Santa Cruz** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: **The Perkins 2 plug system using measuring line and halliburton mixer.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of **Dry** feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
