DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On June 12, at 5:00 AM, 24 hours had elapsed since setting 186 ft. of 5½" OD 14½ J-55 Casing as liner and cementing with 50 sacks. Casing shut-off was tested as follows:

The hole was swabbed and bailed dry above the cement plug and allowed to stand one hour; then cement and cement retainer were drilled and hole bailed dry and allowed to stand two hours. As casing shut-off was OK, workover operations were resumed.
