Following is a report giving the results of work done as indicated above at BOBBS.
Well No. 1. in NE 4 SE 2 1/2 of Sec. 9, T. 19 N, R. 20 E,
N. M. P. M., BOBBS, NEW MEXICO. Oil Field LEA County.

The plan outlined on Form SG 161 was followed except:

Instead of drilling entirely by Standard tools, plan was changed and we drilled by Rotary to the salt, 10" - 40" was set at 1600' and cemented with 90 sacks of cement, (Halliburton Process). Change was made back to Standard tools and at 2900' 8 1/2" - 12" casing was set and cemented with 165 sacks of cement, (Halliburton Process).

The results were as follows: (Give details)
