DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After 24 hour shut-in casing pressure was 720 psig. Pressure between 8-5/8" and 10-3/4" was 700 psig. Pressure between 10-3/4" and 16" was zero psig. Opened annulus between 8-5/8" and 10-3/4" to tanks. Pressure declined to 150 psig in 3 hours. Casing pressure declined to 400 psig at end of test. Gas containing H<sub>2</sub>S produced during test.

Decline of casing pressure and presence of H<sub>2</sub>S in gas indicates leak in 8-5/8". Temperature survey (attached) did not locate leak. Detailed procedure for repairing leak will be submitted later.
