Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company State Well No. 29 in the State of New Mexico

SW 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 19 S, R. 36 E, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was treated with 1,000 gallons Dowell XI Hydrochloric acid solution on December 12th. The well was shut in and left shut in for ninety six hours, until December 18th, when it was pumped in. The gross production was increased from 100 barrels to 212 barrels per day. However, the percentage of water was increased from 60% to 85%. The net production of oil was decreased from 40 barrels to 32 barrels per day.
