Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

16" casing was re-cemented March 20th 1932, plug was drilled March 23rd and 20' hole made below pipe. Hole was bailed dry and allowed to stand 12 hours. Small amount of water coming in hole from behind casing.

Drilling ahead with approval of State Oil & Gas Inspector, with understanding that heavy mud will be circulated ahead of cement when 10-3-4" string of casing is run and cemented.
