Form C-1

This form shall be executed and filed in quadruplicate with the Distribution of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one cor shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the produce and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating owneship and each change in the transporter except that in the case of a terporary change in the transporter involving less than the allowable prodution for one proration period, the operator shall in lieu of filing a new certificate, notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate on alle with the Commission, by lett of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter terporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished such temporary stansporter. Such temporary transporter hall not move any more oil or g s than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and authorization to transport oil or gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until

- (a) Operating ownership charges
- (b) The transporter is changed or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, explain fully under the heading "REMARKS."
