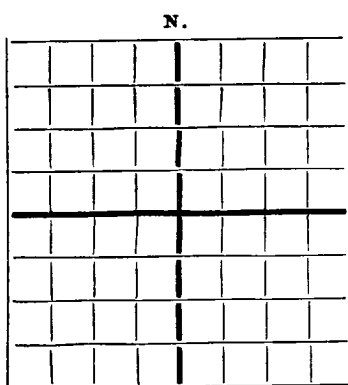

Will set and cement approximately 1700' 10" 45.50 # new seamless casing on top of the salt bed. Will set and cement approximately 4100' 8-5/8" 36# new seamless casing on top of the pay. All work to be done by Rotary Method. All work to be done according to the best oil field practice and conforming to the oil and gas regulations of the State of New Mexico.**
