Dear Mr. Walker:

I regret that I was out of town at the time your wire came and have not been able to write you sooner. I can't understand why this bond matter hasn't been straightened before now. I have copies of letters written to the agents of the bonding company by both Dr. Wells and the writer, which are six weeks old. I also have a copy of a letter written to you under date of June 17th by Dr. Wells advising that the department will accept your personal bond in lieu of the U. S. F. & G. Co. bond. A personal bond form was enclosed.

Apparently from the way your wire reads you have never received this correspondence. I am today sending Wells a copy of your wire and also asking him to see what has caused all the delay. I am positive the personal bond (like we discussed when you were here) will meet with the approval of the department. I am also writing the Santa Fe office, to send you another bond form, (if you haven't already submitted a bond on this form) please make it out and return it to Dr. Wells, State Geologist, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

I am very sorry that it has been necessary for you to write all of the letters and wires to get this matter fixed up. I can't see any excuse for the delay. It is probable that the letter together with bond form written to you by Dr. Wells on June 17th was improperly addressed, as we have had some correspondence with a Walker in Calif.

I trust this delay has not caused you too much inconvenience and hope that our dealings in the future will be with more promptness, Regards,
