This is in reply to your letter  
of June 26th, re: Walker Oil Corporation bond.

I do not have a copy of your letter  
to Mr. Harry Walker under date of June 17th or  
at least I cannot find it or dont remember of  
ever receiving the letter. Mr Walker does not  
stay in this part of the country and I doubt if  
it would be possible for me to contact him regard-  
ing this bond.

I would suggest that you write;  
Dulaney, Johnston, Mankey and Priest, Central Bldg.,  
Wichita, Kansas; Attention: Frank E. Priest, and  
advise them that as soon as the Walker Oil Corp.,  
submits their company bond for approval we can  
release their J. S. F. & C. Co. bond. You might  
also send the Walker Oil Corp., 309 Ellis-Singleton  
Bldg., Wichita, Kansas a copy of this letter.

I don't think Mr. Walker will make  
any objections to a \$10,000.00 bond as long as he  
has no premiums to pay. Should he object to this  
amount, we would be sufficiently protected with one  
for \$5,000.00 on these two wells.

If there is anything further on this  
bond please advise.
