The plan outlined on Form SG XXXX was followed except:

Cemented 15 1/2" 70# casing at 135'8", using forty sacks of cement. The Halliburton method was used in cementing. After the cement has been allowed to set, the hole will be cleaned out to bottom, which is 145', and a water shut-off test will be made.
