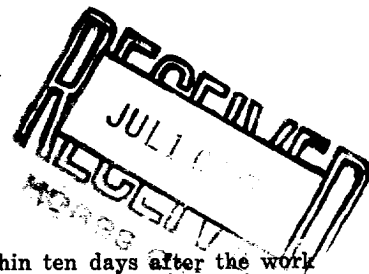

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 6, 1950 at 5:25 P. M., 48 hours had elapsed since cementing the 5-1/2" casing at 7216' with 100 sacks cement. Top of cement from temperature survey was 6675'.

At that time pipe tested satisfactorily with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes. Ninety feet of solid cement was drilled and water shut-off tested satisfactorily with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes.

Completion operations have been resumed.
