## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Hole was loaded with heavy drilling mud.

15 sk. cement plug was placed at T.D or

10 sk. cement plug was placed at 2950 ft. under base of salt.

10 sk. cement plug was placed at 1650ft. above top of salt.

10 sk. cement plug was placed at 1280 ft. in stub of 8 5/8" casing.

8 5/8" casing was shot off at 1280 ft. and pulled.

13 3/8" casing 160 ft. was left in well cemented from bottom to top.

25 sk. cement was placed at 165 ft. under and in bottom of 13 3/8" casing.

42 pipe was cemented in at surface for permanent marker, extending 5 ft. above ground level.

Cleanup was made and all ground around well leveled.
