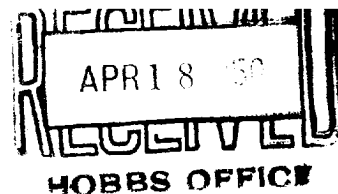

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The 5-1/2" oil string was set at 7290' and cemented with 200 sacks of cement. On April 17, 1950 at 7:30 A. M., 48 hours will have elapsed since setting casing. At this time pipe and water shut off will be tested at 1000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling the cement shoe.

In the event a satisfactory shut-off is not obtained, adequate remedial measures will be taken. If tests are satisfactory, completion operations will be commenced.
