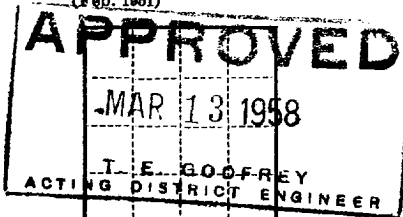

Displaced mud system with brine and drilled salt section from approximately 1870 to 2805'. Set 8 5/8" 32# J-55 casing at 3075' and cemented with 250 sac 4% gel and 100 sac neat cement. Ran temperature survey after 12 hours - top cement at 1694'. WOC 30 hours - pressured casing to 1200 psi for 30 minutes - O.K. Drilling ahead.
