Swabbing test on July 30, indicated sulphur water with no indications of oil or gas. Well was subsequently plugged back from 7989-7938 with twenty sacks of cement which set 48 hours and subsequent swabbing test indicated a satisfactory water shut off of sulphur water.

We now propose to acidize from 7689-7938 with 2000 gallons acid in an effort to stimulate gas production in this section which shows a very small amount of gas and only a trace of oil.
