Gentlemen:

We have received Form C-104 on which you have requested an increase in allowable due to work performed on your Perry Federal No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 22, T-20-S, R-34-E.

Since the well is still producing from the Lynch Pool, it is not necessary to resubmit Form C-104 as you have done, but rather to submit Form C-116, Gas-Oil Ratio Test, requesting the increase. The increase in allowable will be made effective upon the date that Form C-116 is received in this office. We will retain Form C-104, however, in order that we may have a record of the work done.
