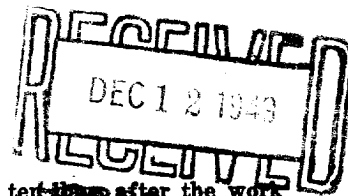

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Moved on WO rig, mixed mud of 40 visc. Aquagel w/5# Krevis Stop per bbl. Killed well, pulled packer, pulled tubing, deepened to 3982' (10' new hole). Ran caliper log, acidized under sweet packer w/2000 gal. 15% HCL Western Acid. Ran 10' Guiberson packer at 3882-3892. Tested packer w/750# CP, o.k. Previous to workover, produced 1.38 barrels of oil, no water and GOR 122,203/1. After workover, December 1, 1949, on 24 hour test pumped 9.45 bbl. oil, no water and GOR 2450/1.
