## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was capable of flowing the top allowable for the Monument field, but would not do so with a gas-oil ratio within the prescribed limitations. Recent tests had shown the ratio on this well as 11324.

A 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" x 30" Emer Dodge Screw Type Formation Packer was set @ 3843' with a perforation below the packer.

The well now produces the rate of allowable (top for Monument) with a gas-oil ratio of 1220.
