DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3930'. This well was completed on August 21, 1936.

This well was re-acidized with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid went in under Maximum of 430# on casing and Vacuum on tubing. Minimum of 400# on casing and Vacuum on tubing. Tubing flushed with 24 barrels oil. Acid allowed to set for 6 hours. Well was then kicked off with gas and flowed 432 barrels oil on 10 hour test through 32/64" choke. Daily gas rate of 999,600. Gas oil ratio of 968. Casing pressure 950#, Tubing pressure 640#. 1/10 of 1% water.
