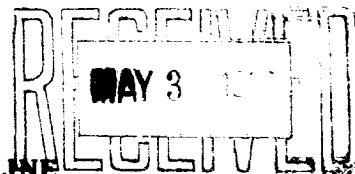

Through 12 open choke on 2 1/2" upset tubing. Daily gas rate of 3,640,000 the last hour. Gas oil ratio of 1628. Tubing pressure 400#. Casing pressure 1250#.
