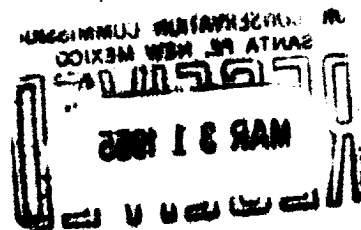

Re: Application to Dually complete
State "F" No. 1, Eumont Pool,
Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

By copy of this letter Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (A) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation State "F" No. 1 is located 660' FSL and 660' FWL of Section 36, Township 19-S, Range 36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located on a 160 acre lease being the SW/4 of Section 36. The well was completed May 15, 1935 as an oil well in the Monument Pool.
- (B) That this well was assigned a 160 acre unit upon approval by the Commission, December 1, 1953, consisting of the SW/4 of Section 36, Township 19-S, Range 36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (C) That the subject well has been producing gas from the braden head for sale to Permian Basin Pipe Line Company since December 27, 1953.
- (D) That the subject well was worked over in August and September, 1954 and the braden head gas was killed.
- (E) That the subject well was dually completed after approval by the Commission, of Form C-102 dated March 1, 1955.
- (F) That the applicant dually completed this well in the following manner:
 - (1) Perforated the 7" casing from 3274' to 3352'.
 - (2) Set production type packer at 3677' to separate the two zones.
 - (3) Producing the San Andres oil through the tubing and the Queen gas through the tubing-casing annulus. The attached Exhibit B is a diagrammatic sketch of the dual completion.
