The purpose of this letter is to request that our State "F" Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 36, Twp. 19-S, Range 36-E, Monument Field, Lea County, New Mexico, be classified as a bradenhead gas well, in addition to an oil producing well.

The bradenhead gas is being produced from 3135' to 3183' in the Seven Rivers Formation, which has been successfully cased off from the underlying oil reservoir located from 3805' to 3903', in the San Andres Formation.

Should additional information be required to classify this well as a bradenhead gas well, in addition to an oil producing well, please advise.
