The purpose of this letter is to request the reclassification of our State "F" Well No. 5, located in the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 36, Twp. 19-S, Range 36-E, Monument-McKee Field, Lea County, New Mexico, from an oil well to a gas well.

This well is producing from 9890' to 9907' in the Simpson formation. During the month of February, 1950, the well produced 327.36 barrels of distillate, which would average 11.69 barrels per day.
