DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Moved in WO rig, 250 bbl. tank, hauled water, mixed tank of Aquagel mud, 40 visc. w/2% Krovis Stop per bbl; killed well, pulled tubing w/OV packer, cleaned out, ran HOWSO measuring line, re-ran tubing w/Sanderson spiral formation packer, sheared pin, pulled out, ran junk basket, re-dressed packer, re-ran packer, set @ 3875/85', tested w/600# OK, swabbed well in; until 6:00 AM 6/2/49, flowed and swabbed approx 173.00 bbls oil, 5% water. Before WO, well was making approx 10.00 bbls oil, 3% water per day, w/OCR of 12,527/l; after WO, 24 hr test, 1/4" chh, submitted on Form C-116, prod 42.07 bbls oil, 4.16 bbls water w/OCR of 1200/l.
