FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

1. Place 400' plug @ 4160' (top @ 3760) confining bottom sulphur water and covering several very weak non-commercial shows.
2. Place 50' plug below salt @ approx. 2650' - 2700'
3. Place 50' plug above salt @ approx. 1750' - 1800'
4. Place 50' plug extending from below surface pipe into surface pipe, from approx. 300'-250'.
5. Plug top of surface pipe w/5 sax and place regulation 4" marker in same, extending 4' above ground.
