NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Jerry
Well No. 13 in SW 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 19S, R. 38E
N. M. P. M., Hobbs Oil Field Lea County,
on Dec. 3, 1929 45.5 lb. casing was { ~~landed~~ } in Lime
formation at a depth of 2890 feet on Dec. 3, 1929
420 sacks of Incor cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: The Perkins 2-plug system was used with the Halliburton method.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of Dry feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

The cement will be allowed to set for five days, and then the plugs will be drilled out and a water shut-off test will be made.
