On or about February 17, 1947, we intend to deepen the above well with cable tools. We will drill 15 feet and then squeeze the open hole from 2953' to 3019' with about 50 sacks cement by Halliburton. Then we will drill 6" hole to about 3085' and attempt to produce from the lower pay of the Salt Lake Pool.
